With the help of supporters and volunteers, Second Harvest Food Bank works through a network of hundreds of partner agencies and programs to provide nutritious food to *more than 400,000* hungry children, seniors, and families in Orange County every month.

Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County provides Meals for Kids, Groceries for Seniors, and Fresh Food for Families and Individuals.

- At least one in seven children in our community are at risk of hunger
- In Orange County nearly half of all public-school children rely on reduced or free school lunches for their main source of nutrition
- Many seniors live on fixed incomes and cannot afford necessities like food, rent and medication
- Due to high rents and an increasing cost of living, it is sometimes impossible for even those with jobs to afford food, rent and other necessities.
