Theresa Truman is the Assistant Director, Deputy Title IX Officer at UCI. She is a Sexual Violence and Discrimination Investigator with experience working for state agencies, the federal government, higher education, and private industry in which she conducts confidential and complex investigations of allegations of sexual violence, sexual harassment, and discrimination in employment, higher education, housing, and places of public accommodation.

She has investigated hundreds of charges of sexual harassment, sexual violence (sexual assault, stalking, dating and domestic violence), discrimination, and retaliation and has created and implemented policies, procedures, and training programs for compliance with Title IX and VAWA (Violence Against Women Act).

She delivers interactive and engaging presentations to the public on the Civil Rights Act, Title VII, Title IX, the ADA/ADAAA, reasonable accommodations, the EPA, the ADEA and state statutes.

She will be discussing the impact of the “Me Too” movement and what it means for the women at UCI and her assessment of the future of the movement. Please join us for what should be an interesting and inspiring discussion.
