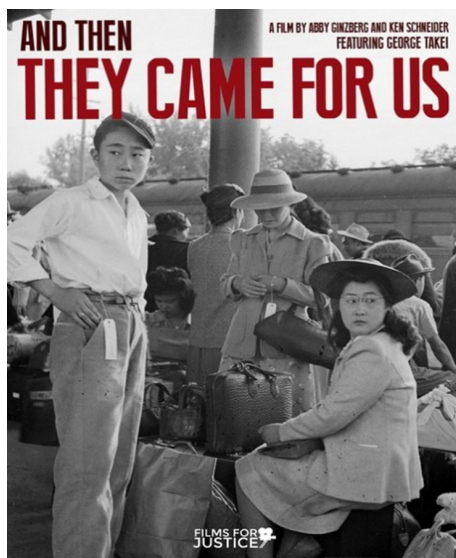

And Then They Came for Us: This award winning documentary brings history into the present, retelling the difficult story of Japanese Americans being interned and follows Japanese-American activists as they speak out against the Muslim registry and travel ban. Seventy-five years ago, nearly 120,000 Japanese Americans were forced to leave their homes, their jobs, their schools and their livelihoods to live in armed camps during World War II.

The documentary film ***And Then They Came for Us*** features activist, George Takei, activist, producer, and professor Emeritus Satsuki, Ph.D, and many others who were incarcerated, as well as newly rediscovered photographs by Dorothea Lange along with interviews with former detainees.

Knowing our history is the first step to ensuring we do not repeat it.
