Our meetings continued with "Moms Demand Action in Orange County," "American Democracy: How Democracy is Being Attacked" with David Pepper, the League of Women Voters' presentation "Pros & Cons of California State-wide Propositions," viewing and moderated discussion of "Critical Race Theory: The War on African American Education" featuring Kevin Myles, and finally "White Power and American Democracy" with Kathleen Belew.

Through your membership, we were able to donate money to groups supporting progressive interests such as the League of Women Voters, Mons Demand Action, and the League of Women Voters. We have also continued to support legislation that aligns with our core mission to advocate for causes that create a better world.
