Steph Campbell will represent the League of Women Voters and provide for us the Pros and Cons on the propositions. Currently there are 11 statewide propositions, a smaller number than normal. The November 6, 2018, Statewide Ballot Measures are:

- Bonds for various Housing Assistance
- Bonds to Fund Projects for Water Supply and Quality.
- Bonds for construction at hospitals providing children's health care.
- Change to requirements for certain property owners to transfer their property tax base—relating to Prop 13.
- Requiring certain fuel taxes and vehicle fees to be approved by the electorate.
- Repeal of the Daylight Savings Time Act.
- Regulates Amounts Outpatient Kidney Dialysis Clinics Charge for Dialysis.
- Expands Local Governments' Authority to Enact Rent Control on Residential Property.
- Requires Private-Sector Emergency Ambulance Employees to Remain On-Call During Work Breaks.
- Establishes New Standards for Confinement of Specified Farm Animals; Bans Sale of Noncomplying Products.
