Mig founded The Todd Anglin Home for Children in 2005. The Home was established as a memorial to her son, Todd whose life was lost in a tragic accident when he was 28years old. Todd Anglin cared deeply for poverty stricken and vulnerable children. The Home is designed to care for abandoned, abused, and at risk children by meeting each child physical, emotional, and educational needs. Orphanages have been established in Managua, Nicaragua and Tijuana, Mexico.

Deborah Hernandez

Deborah Hernandez is the Mothers Demand Action Orange County ambassador, and communications leader for the California Chapter. In 2014 she advocated for the passage of Assembly Bill 1014, for gun violence restraining orders, which was signed into law by Governor Jerry Brown. In 2015 she worked on the local and state level, a plan for an increased emphasis on "child access prevention."
